



May 21st, 2025 Council Meeting Highlights

- A public meeting was held regarding the Council's decision to change its composition from eight members to five, effective for the 2026 Municipal Election. No public feedback was received.
- The single surface chip seal resurfacing of Olde Drive (from Thames Road to Dundonald Road) and Pratt Siding Road (from Centreville Drive to Trillium Drive), as included in the 2025 budget, will be completed by the Municipality of Middlesex Centre.
- The Bridge and Culverts Engineering Services Request for Proposal (RFP) was awarded to Spriet Associates Engineers and Architects in the amount of \$142,510.00 (excluding HST).
- Glencoe District High School Pollinator Gardens were recognized for their significant contributions to environmental sustainability, their efforts to restore vital ecosystems, and their role in inspiring community action.
- The following by-laws were approved:
 - Agreement with the Glencoe Agricultural Society for use of their facilities as an emergency shelter.
 - Sale of designated surplus land in Wardsville to Halide Emulsion Labs Inc.

- Planning highlights:
 - Consent Application B1-2025 – 22760 Pratt Siding Road was approved, subject to conditions.
 - Consent Application B2-2025 – Part of Lot 6, Concession 5 was approved, subject to conditions.
 - A public meeting was held for Zoning By-law Amendment Application P3-2025 – North side of Appin Road (County Road 14) East of Stella Avenue. A report will be coming back to a future council meeting.
- Drainage highlights:
 - Assessments levied for the Gardiner Drain 2025, Gould Drain 2025 and the Stinson McCallum Drain 2025 were confirmed.
 - Engineer reports were received for the Hagle Drain 2025 and the McCahon-Trillium Drain 2025, with both by-laws receiving their first and second readings.
 - A Section 78 request for improvement was approved for the Downie Drain.
