



# June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025 Council Meeting Highlights

- Council received a presentation from Brian Kavanagh, P.Eng. CMO, Principal from Infralevel Inc. regarding the draft Asset Management Plan and Policy, which would make Southwest Middlesex compliant with the 2024 and 2025 requirements of Ontario Regulation 588/17. The plan and policy were approved and can be viewed on the Southwest Middlesex website.
- Council listened to a presentation from Hydro One regarding the Longwood to Lakeshore Project. As a reminder, there is an open house being held at the Glencoe Agricultural Hall (268 Currie Street) on Thursday, June 12<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. All are welcome to attend. - Council directed staff to continue to gather information regarding proposed Wind Energy Projects within Southwest Middlesex, to be brought back to Council.
- Council endorsed the submission of an application to the Municipal Housing Infrastructure Program - Health and Safety Water Stream (MHIP-HSWS) for Phase 1 of the Glencoe Outlet Drain Project.
- Council awarded the Stormwater Rate Study Request for Proposal (RFP) to Watson & Associates Economists Ltd. in the amount of \$43,514 + HST.

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- Council directed staff to contact concerned residents/ property owners on McMaster Place regarding their feedback on streetlight installation.
- Council approved an additional \$15,000 in funding from the recreation reserves to allow for the completion of lighting replacement on one of the baseball diamonds in Glencoe due to increased costs.
- Council awarded the Project 2000 Concession Request for Proposal (RFP) to “Huddle Hut”. They will be opening for the summer of 2025.
- The following by-laws were approved:
  - Loan agreement with Middlesex County towards the Glencoe Business and Industrial Park Servicing Project.
  - Purchase agreement for the land and property at 21996 Hagerty Road, Wardsville.
