

# 2025 Sidewalk Replacement Program

Dear Property Owner/Resident,

The Municipality of Southwest Middlesex will soon commence a sidewalk construction project in your area This letter provides details about the project with important information on how the project may impact you.

## **Project Details**

**Location:** Melbourne

**Schedule:** Tentative start date – June 23, 2025

Estimated completion – August 1, 2025

**Scope:** The existing sidewalk will be removed and disposed of to allow for the

installation of a new concrete sidewalk. The new sidewalk will be constructed to meet current accessibility standards and improve

pedestrian safety.

**Contractor:** Municipality of Southwest Middlesex & Fiorino Concrete Ltd.

## **How will Construction Impact You?**

**Street Access and Parking:** Streets and sidewalks will have restrictions during construction, only allowing local traffic to access their properties. Staff and the contractor will work with impacted properties as it relates to driveway impacts and access to property.

**Vibration – Protect Valuables:** Construction equipment can cause vibrations. Please ensure you protect any valuables susceptible to damage.


**Mail Services:** Canada post will continue to deliver mail during construction. Canada Post will provide further notification and instructions for residents that may be impacted.

**Garbage and Recycling Collection:** If your pick-up point is temporarily blocked by construction the Municipality & contractor will assist in collecting and transporting your garbage and recycling.

**Lawns & Boulevards:** The Municipality will restore all damaged lawns & boulevards resulting from the construction project. A mixture of seeds and topsoil will be applied by the Municipality to the affected locations. We encourage you to assist in the watering process.
