- “Sundays at the Station” provided Council an overview of their status and events from 2025.
- A 5-year extension was approved for Mr. Tountas and his refreshment vehicle located at the Glencoe Train Station parking lot.
- A finalized agreement was signed with Chatham-Kent and Newbury regarding the operation and monitoring of the Limerick Landfill
- Council approved staff to seek formal clarification from the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing (MMAH) regarding ‘Strong Mayor Powers’ for Southwest Middlesex after the 2026 Municipal Election

- Upcoming Municipal Election policies were reviewed and approved. These policies will form part of the Election Candidates package.
- Public Works provided Council an overview of Recycling Service changes and Council approved collection for 2026 to allow commercial properties.
