

**NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION**



The Municipality of Southwest Middlesex is planning to extend Tower Avenue in the community of Glencoe to service industrial lands generally described as Range 2 NLR Part Lot 24. This project area is located on the site of the future Glencoe Industrial Park.

The proposed road extension would involve the construction of a municipal road extension, with watermains, sanitary sewers, storm sewers, and a stormwater management facility, to service industrial development planned for the project area. The planned new road would extend from Industrial Road approximately 340 meters to a turn-around circle. This road is intended to serve industrial lots within the project area. The land within the Class EA project area is owned by the Municipality.

The planning for this project is following the environmental screening process set out for Schedule B activities under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) document. The screening process has been completed and no potential negative impacts were identified with the proposed road extension that could not be adequately mitigated. Subject to any comments received as a result of this notice and the receipt of necessary approvals, the Municipality intends to proceed with this project during the 2026 and 2027 construction seasons.

Interested persons may provide written comments to our project team by April 12, 2026. All Comments and concerns should be sent directly to Chris Lierman at Spriet Associates. Refer to the contact information listed above.

In addition, a request may be made to the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks for an order requiring a higher level of study (i.e. requiring an individual/comprehensive EA approval before being able to proceed), or that conditions be imposed (e.g. require further studies), only on the grounds that the requested order may prevent, mitigate, or remedy adverse impacts on constitutionally protected aboriginal and treaty rights. Requests on other grounds will not be considered. Requests should include the requester contact information and full name.

Requests should specify what kind of order is being requested (request for conditions or a request for an individual/comprehensive environmental assessment), how an order may prevent, mitigate, or remedy adverse impacts on Aboriginal and treaty rights, and any information in support of the statements in the request.
