## At this meeting, Council:

- Adopted a new Accessibility Policy.
- Received a report on the 2026 Municipal Election Accessibility Plan.
- Renewed the Lease Agreement with the Elm Children's Centre.
- Received a report on the Ekfrid Roof Top Unit Replacement.
- Received a report on the Elm Children's Centre Second Entrance.

## Drainage Highlights:

- Awarded the tender for the James Lethbridge Drain to Robinson Farm Drainage Limited in the amount \$274,177.00 (Excluding HST)

## Planning Highlights:

- Adopted Official Plan Amendment No.7, a housekeeping amendment to implement updates to policy direction for Additional Residential Units (ARUs) was adopted.
- Approved Zoning by-law Amendment P1-2026 to Lift the Holding Symbol at 6170 Glendon Drive.
- Adopted Zoning By-law Amendment P13-2000 to rezone a proposed severed parcel at 3872 Parkhouse Drive.

## By-laws Approved:

- Authorized the execution of an agreement with the County of Middlesex for the "Can I Play Too" program
- Authorizing credit facilities from the Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce (CIBC) to meet expenditures in connection with the annual operating and capital works and Bridge Loan Financing.
