1. Introduction

Project 2000 is seeking proposals from qualified vendors, individuals, or organizations to manage and operate the **Project 2000 Food Booth** during the 2026 season. The selected contractor will be responsible for the preparation, sale, and cleanup associated with food and beverage offerings at the booth.

2. Background

The Project 2000 Food Booth is a vital part of our community engagement and fundraising efforts. For more than 20 years, it has been a staple at local soccer and baseball events, as well as the annual Fall Fair. The booth traditionally offers hamburgers, hot dogs, french fries, ice cream, assorted snacks, and beverages, providing a popular gathering place for residents and visitors alike.

This year, we are excited to welcome the ISC World Championships for a week-long event in August, bringing athletes, families, and spectators from across North America to our community. The Project 2000 Food Booth will play an important role in helping serve guests while showcasing the hospitality and community spirit that make our area special.

3. Scope of Services

The selected contractor will be responsible for the following:

- Providing food preparation, service, and cleanup
- Staffing the booth with trained and certified food handlers
- Ensuring compliance with local health and safety regulations
- Procuring and transporting food, beverages, and supplies
- Managing cash and/or electronic payment transactions
- Maintaining a clean and professional presentation of the booth



Optional services may include:

- Menu development in collaboration with Project 2000
 - Marketing and promotion of food offerings

All proposals must include the following:

- **Cover Letter:** Brief introduction and interest in the contract
 - **Experience & Qualifications:** Relevant background in food service operations
 - **Health & Safety Compliance:** Proof of current certifications, insurance, and licensing
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5. Proposal Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Relevant experience and qualifications (30%)
 - Proposed menu and pricing (20%)
 - Operational plan and staffing (20%)
 - Cost and financial proposal (20%)
 - References and reputation (10%)
