



Bridge & Culvert Rehabilitation Projects

Dear Property Owner/Resident,

The Municipality of Southwest Middlesex will be undertaking a bridge and culvert rehabilitation project on your road. This letter is intended to provide information about the project, including important details regarding potential impacts on residents and motorists during construction.

The bridge and culvert rehabilitation projects were approved by Council on February 18, 2026. The work will involve concrete rehabilitation and repairs to existing bridge and culvert structures, extending their service life while improving roadway safety and the long-term durability of the Municipality's transportation infrastructure.

- Location: CPR Drive (Dundonald Road to Old Airport Road)
CPR Drive (Big Bend Road to Pine Road)
Knapdale Drive (Dundonald Road to Old Airport Road)
Argyll Drive (Dundonald Road to Old Airport Road)
Argyll Drive (Old Airport Road to Pratt Siding Road)
Gentleman Drive (Melbourne Road to Springfield Road)
- Schedule: Tentative start date – July 13, 2026 (Weather Permitting)
Estimated completion – September 25, 2026
- Scope: Concrete rehabilitation and repairs to existing bridge and culvert structures.
- Contractor: Vandenberg Construction Inc.

How will Construction Impact You?

Road Access: The contractor will work with impacted properties as it relates to driveway impacts and access to property.

Vibration – Protect Valuables: Construction equipment can cause vibrations. Please ensure you protect any valuables susceptible to damage.



Mail Services: Canada post will continue to deliver mail during construction. Canada Post will provide further notification and instructions for residents that may be impacted.

Garbage and Recycling Collection: If your pick-up point is temporarily blocked by construction the Municipality & contractor will assist in collecting and transporting your garbage and recycling.
