WHEREAS, there was a recent discovery of the remains of 215 children at the site of a former residential school in British Columbia which serves as a horrifying reminder of the abuse Indigenous People in Canada face, and have faced; and

WHEREAS, when colonization began, one of the first tactics was to remove Indigenous Peoples from the land, attempting to sever a connection that runs thousands of years deep; and

WHEREAS, as a result of colonization, Indigenous People have faced genocide, broken treaties, control of resources and food access, forced into residential schools, including the Sixties Sweep; and

WHEREAS, it is important to consider what has happened in the past and what changes can be made going forward; and

WHEREAS, the municipality can take steps to support Indigenous communities and potentially inspire others to do the same; and

WHEREAS, recognition of history can be a small step towards reconciliation; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Municipality of Southwest Middlesex reach out to local First Nations, Indigenous Organizations, and Community Champions to develop a land acknowledgement to focus on our Indigenous residents and neighbouring First Nations' communities; and

THAT and we all come back with some research and self reflection, because it is

not the responsibility of First Nations to write our land acknowledgement; and THAT an adopted land acknowledgement statement be listed on the municipal website, read before council meetings, and at special municipal events.
